With Hands Free Notes create Notes and List easy and practical (To Do List)

Some features that are our differential:

1 - Voice commands

"You can create 'Lists' or 'Notes' with a voice command only

- * Include, change, delete, search
- * The commands can be configured in any language.
- * The commands must be identified by the voice recognition function of your cell phone
- * For the same command you can configure up to 4 words that will be accepted

2 - Mark function

* For example in a supermarket list you have several items registered and you will not always buy all items.

"With the 'Mark' function, you can quickly place the products you will buy on this next purchase at the top of the list.

3 - In 'Menu-Settings' you can:

- * Configure the font size in Notes
- * Select if the notes will be protected by password or by reading the fingerprint.
- * Enable / Disable Voice command
- * Others ...

4 - Help:

On all screens, if you make a Long Click (click and hold) on the buttons and figures a help text will appear.

- * In the configuration of the voice commands there is a picture of a 'microphone' that you click on, waiting for the flag to turn green and speak the word of a command that you want to use and check if the voice recognition recognizes easy.
- * If you want to use this word, just put it in the option you want (it will automatically be available in the clipboard).

Voice Commands Configuration

Hands Free Notes ('HFN') can be controlled via voice command, such as:

- * Create a new 'Text or a new' List '.
- * Open an existing 'Text or' List '.
- * Skip the Line.
- * Cancel last spoken text.

On each page of the application there is a 'Help' function to be able to check which commands are available on the screen.

Always before speaking a command, a key word is spoken indicating to the application that a command to be interpreted follows.

To be a command, it must be said at the beginning of recognition (after the application has interpreted the last word or phrase).

Initially we set the word 'OK' which is short and easy to pronounce but in the settings of the voice commands ('Menu-Config. Voice') it is possible to change and put any other that you consider more practical.

For example to start a new list the command is "OK List"

The HFN has the interface, today, in English and Portuguese but the commands can be configured in any language such as Spanish, French, German, any that the voice recognition of your cell phone understands.

In 'Menu - Voice Config' you have a list of all existing commands and their functions and the words chosen to execute.

Available Commands

The commands are already configured with the words to be used to execute it

These words can be changed or added to perform the same commands.

For example, the command "Open" that opens an existing Note or List can be configured with the word 'open' and the word 'open' or even 'open' (you can configure up to 4). So any of them the HFN will understand that is to open a Note or Text.

Command List

"Command" This is the Key word that will indicate to the 'HFN' that a command to be interpreted will be spoken next.

Initially, the words "OK" or the symbol "*" are configured.

Then to start a command, say "OK" + command.

If "OK" is in the middle of the text it will not be interpreted as a command.

So if you are saying a phrase like "Tomorrow continue project OK"

Commands

Note:

- 1 - In "Words" the commands are already configured with 1 or 2 words that can be modified and registered up to 4 variations
- 2 - The commands in the background premium version not yet available
- 3 - "Voice Feedback": is spoken with configured to return commands accepted by voice
- 4- Commands in background still not available

- • **"Note"**
 - Function: Create a new TEXT Note
 - Words: "note"
 - Where:
 - On the Home screen
 - In the background
 - Voice Feedback: "new text."

- • **"List"**
 - Function: Creates a new LIST Note
 - Words: "list"
 - Where:
 - On the Home screen
 - In the background
 - Voice Feedback: "new text."
- • **"Item"**
 - Function: create a new Item in a List
 - Words: "item"
 - Where:
 - List
 - Item (instead of saving and inserting a new item, just start a new item and the app already saves the previous one.)
 - Voice Feedback: "new item"
- • **"Line"**
 - Function: Line skip when editing TEXT or ITEM
 - Words: "line"
 - Where:
 - Text
 - Item
 - In the background
 - Voice Feedback: "new line"
- • **"Open"**
 - Function: Open a TEXT or LIST for editing then say the number to be edited. In numbers up to 9 the ideal is to say "OK OPEN 09"
 - Words: "open; open"
 - Where:
 - Home
 - List
 - In the background
 - Voice Feedback: "Open NOTE"

HFN – Hands Free Notes

- • **“Title”**
 - Function: Position the cursor on the Title to be modified. When nothing is placed, the app places part of the first TEXT line or first ITEM. To exit the Title edition, say “OK TEXT”
 - Words: “title”
 - Where:
 - Text
 - List
 - In the background
 - Voice Feedback: “title”
- • **“Text”**
 - Function: Position the courses in the TEXT field (leaves the Title field)
 - Words: “text”
 - Where:
 - Text
 - List
 - In the background
 - Voice Feedback: “text”
- **“Top”**
 - Function: Place the Note in the first position. Then it says the number to be edited. In numbers up to 9 the ideal is to say “OK OPEN 09’
 - Words: “top”
 - Where:
 - Main page
 - Voice Feedback: “Note at the top”
- **“Mark”**
 - Function: Mark (place in the first position) / Deselect (place below the last marked item) the Item. Then it says the number to be marked. In numbers up to 9 the ideal is to say “OK OPEN 09’
 - Words: “mark; mark; select”
 - Where:
 - List
 - Voice Feedback: “Mark Item”

HFN – Hands Free Notes

- **“Bigger”**
 - Function: Temporarily increases the letter of the typed text for easier reading. When you start the program again, the letters return to the size defined in “Settings”
 - Words: “bigger”
 - Where:
 - Text
 - List
 - Item
 - Voice Feedback: “Bigger Letter ”
- **“Smaller”**
 - Function: Temporarily decreases the letter of the typed text. When you start the program again, the letters return to the size defined in “Settings”
 - Words: “smaller”
 - Where:
 - Text
 - List
 - Item
 - Voice Feedback: “Smaller Letter”
- **“Normal”**
 - Function: Returns the font size to the value defined in “Settings”
 - Words: “normal”
 - Where:
 - Text
 - List
 - Item
 - Voice Feedback: “Normal Letter”

HFN – Hands Free Notes

- **“Back”**
 - Function: Back to Previous Screen
 - Words: “back”
 - Where:
 - Text
 - List
 - Item
 - Voice Feedback: “Back”
- **“Save”**
 - Function: Saves the Text or Item
 - Words: “save”
 - Where:
 - Text
 - Item
 - In the background
 - Voice Feedback: “Save”
- **“Read”**
 - Function: Read the Text, Checked Items on List or Item
 - Words: “to read”
 - Where:
 - Text
 - List
 - Item
 - In the background
 - Voice Feedback: “Read the Text”
- **“Proteger”**
 - Function: Protect the Text or List. When opening it will be necessary to enter the Master password or read the Fingerprint as configured in ‘Settings’
 - Words: “protect; lock”
 - Where:
 - Text
 - List
 - Voice Feedback: “Protect”

HFN – Hands Free Notes

- **“Cancel”**
 - Function: Deletes the last spoken text
 - Words: “cancel”
 - Where:
 - Text
 - List
 - Item
 - In the background
 - Voice Feedback: “Cancel the last text”
- **“Delete”**
 - Function: Deletes the Note, List or entire Item
 - Words: “delete”
 - Where:
 - Text
 - List
 - Item
 - In the background
 - Voice Feedback: “Erase everything”
- **“Last”**
 - Function: Deletes the last word of the text (until the space before the last word)
 - Words: “last”
 - Where:
 - Text
 - List
 - Item
 - Voice Feedback: “Erase last word”
- **“Yes”**
 - Function: In a dialog on the screen confirms
 - Words: “yes”
 - Where:
 - Dialogues
 - Voice Feedback: “yes”

HFN – Hands Free Notes

- **“No”**
 - Function: In a dialog on the screen does not confirm
 - Words: “no”
 - Where:
 - Dialogues
 - Voice Feedback: “no”
- **“Search”**
 - Function: Active / Deactive search field for searching in Notes and Items
 - Words: “search ”
 - Where:
 - Main screen
 - List
 - Voice Feedback: “search”
- **“Help”**
 - Function: Shows the voice commands available on that screen
 - Words: “help”
 - Where:
 - Main screen
 - List
 - Item
 - Voice Feedback: “Help”
